If these conditions are not met the load will be refused for shipment.

TOTE will waive the aforementioned conditions if shipper releases TOTE from liability for damages as a result of weather, stack soot, sea water, or any other outside element. Shipper must annotate the bill of lading to read "No TOTE liability for damage caused by outdoor exposure."
